September 3, 1932 - July 25, 2021

U.S. Army Ret. SGM Bart Carson Brown, 88, of Fayetteville, NC, passed away on Sunday, July 25, 2021 at Cape Fear Valley Medical Center.

He was born on September 3, 1932 in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, in the county of Titus to the late Albert R. Brown and Jessie Heffner Brown.

Medals, awards & commendations: SGM Brown retired from the Army in September 1984 after 30 years of service then worked at the Small Business Administration, Little Rock, Arkansas for many years. Some of his assignments included the 8th Special Forces in Panama Canal in which he was one of the original members; the 5th Special Forces in Vietnam and a member of the Mike Force; and the Vietnamese Airborne (Red Hat). He had several other assignments which included the XVIII Airborne and he was the Post Sergeant Major at the Presidio of San Francisco. Some of his awards and decorations included: the Bronze Star (last Oak Leaf Cluster); Meritorious Service Medal (2d Oak Leaf Cluster); Army Commendation Medal; Combat Infantry Badge; Special Forces Tab; Parachutists Badge; Good Conduct Medal (9th Award); Army Occupation Medal; Army Service Medal; Overseas Service Ribbon; Presidential Unit Citation; Joint Service Commendation medal; Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal; Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry w/palm; and Republic of Vietnam Staff Service Medal.

He is survived by his loving wife of 59 years Trudy Brown, of the home; and a daughter Linda Heinly and her husband, Daniel, of Fayetteville, NC; grandchildren: Kimberly Morris and husband Steven of Raleigh, NC, and

Kathy Biesaga and Husband Pawel of Raleigh, NC;
great-grandchildren, Kayla, Kamryn and Evan Biesaga of Raleigh, NC.
