May 28, 1954 - March 17, 2024

Command Sergeant Major Frederick George Paul, aged 69, passed away peacefully at home with family in Fayetteville, NC on March 17, 2024. CSM Paul served in the US Army as a Combat Engineer (1st CAV DIV) for 25 years and was awarded a Bronze Star Medal, along with many other accommodations.
