June 26, 1921 - March 12, 2018

Henry Lee Page, 96, of Fayetteville passed away at the VA Medical Center on Monday, March 12, 2018.

He was a Coxswain in the US Navy, serving from 1939-1946. He was not only a Pearl Harbor survivor, but also survived multiple battles throughout the South Pacific. He earned six bronze stars and many commendations to include the Navy Unit Commendation, the American and the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medals, the World War II Victory Medal and Honorable Service Pin. Henry was proud of his brave service in the US Navy during WWII and continuing his education, graduating from Western Pennsylvania Horological Institute in 1948. He was a loving family man with a career of 43 years with the Jewel Box as a watch maker.

He is survived by his wife, Edna Huggins Page; daughter, LaRue Page Cooke of Fayetteville; sons George Henry Page of Isle of Palms, SC and Randall Wade Page of Fayetteville; 4 grandchildren and 1 great-grandchild.

There will be a graveside service on Wednesday, March 14, at 1:00 pm at Lafayette Memorial Park, 2301 Ramsey Street, Fayetteville with John Cook officiating. There will be a visitation with the family at the home after the service.
