“ I live in Australia and only met Ed in person for the first time in May last year, but he has touched my life for good far more profoundly than this large distance and short duration would suggest. If not for Ed, it is probable that a friendship I hold most dear would never have happened.

About 33 years ago, Ed's friendship and witness had a deep influence on a young friend and student of his. As a result, Ed was directly responsible for his friend (whom I was to meet many years later) becoming a follower of Jesus. I will be forever grateful to Ed for introducing my friend Brettany to Christ, and for his many prayers on her behalf.

After Brettany and I became friends, it was inevitable that - with Ed being her special, most long-term friend - I would one day be put in touch with him. And so it happened, at first via Facebook. Apart from our mutual close friend, we also shared a love of Jesus, terrible puns (the worse the better), Monty Python, and some other obscurities. Although I definitely wasn't on Ed's intellectual level, he nevertheless seemed to enjoy our occasional interactions. Sometimes our opinions diverged, but there was never any doubt where Ed's heart lay: on the side of God's Kingdom.

Ed was so, so proud of his family - his wife Kim, his daughter Stephanie (and her servant-heart as a missionary with YWAM), his son Matthew, and especially his beloved grandchildren. He couldn't wait to connect me with Stephanie; almost as soon as I got to know Ed I had also become one of Stephanie's 2000 Facebook friends, the beneficiary of her frequent witty and poignant posts.

I visited Asheville, NC last May for Brettany's long-awaited university graduation. Another highlight of that time was a much-anticipated side-trip all the way to Southern Pines to meet Ed in person at last. The Blatchley family and I had a delightful morning with Ed and his lovely, gentleman father Jack. I was genuinely thrilled to be able to bring them some homemade rosella jam and a

*few other Aussie delicacies. We ate Krispy Kreme donuts, laughed and talked, Skyped Kim (who was away on a work trip), and took the attached photo to remember the occasion.*

*We were not to know it would be the only time we would meet here in this life.*

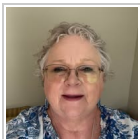

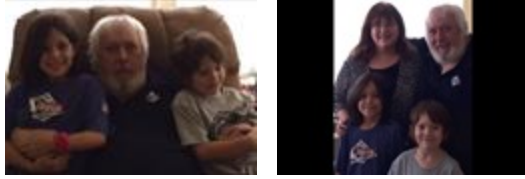
