



LTC Kenneth James Winchell

LTC Kenneth J. Winchell, 85 of Fayetteville, passed away at his residence Monday, August 4, 2014 surrounded by his loving family.

LTC Winchell retired from the United States Army after 25 years of service in 1972. He was awarded medals and commendations from the Korean and Vietnam war's. He joined the Special Forces Family in 1965, and worked mainly in the John F. Kennedy Headquarters. He was the G-2 Intelligence Officer, and also the G-3 Operation's Officer. He joined the Special Forces Association in 1976, and remained a member for 37 years. After Mr. Winchell retired from the military, he became the Owner of the Charles Chips Franchise of Fayetteville for over 25 years - and known to most as "The Charlie Chip Man".

He was preceded in death by his parents, Kenneth M. Winchell and Florence F. Winchell; son, Donald Winchell; and son-in-law, Alan Pye.

He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Peggy J. Winchell of the home; daughters, Debbie Pye of Fayetteville; Carol May of Appling, GA; sons, James Winchell and wife Mary of Fayetteville; Michael Winchell and wife Mary of Waverly, VA; 7 grandchildren; 2 great-grandchildren.

A mass will be held at 1:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 12, 2014 in St. Patrick Catholic Church with visitation 1 hour prior to the service. Burial will follow at Lafayette Memorial Park. The Rev. Father Patrick Keane will officiate.
