Mrs. Teresa Zahran Vaught, 78 of Nebo, North Carolina, passed away peacefully surrounded by her loving family on June 11, 2023, after a long battle with cancer.

Teresa was born on January 20, 1945, and was a native of Fayetteville, NC. She was preceded in death by her parents, the prominent jewelers, Fred and Rome Zahran of Rome's Jewelers. She graduated from Fayetteville High School in 1963.
